POSITION SUMMARY: Responsible for providing an exceptional experience to aquatics competition competitors, coaches, and spectators by delivering precise execution of Timing System Operator and/or Scoreboard Operator duties during swim meets.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist in setup and removal of timing system components, and quickly replace components if necessary during events
- Provide effective and efficient technical support during the operation of swim meets of various sizes by operating the meet management and/or scoreboard computer (Colorado Timing System 6)
- Data entry input and maintain the master score sheet. Prints and disseminates results, awards, and award labels as necessary
- In the event the of an equipment malfunction or failure manually record results and disseminate as necessary
- Adhere to facility standards including safety and cleanliness standards
- Attend staff meetings and trainings related specifically to competitive events
- Follow policies and procedures, including those related to medical situations and emergencies
- Maintain competition scoring equipment
- Other duties as assigned
